Health Science Career Interviews



Your group is to choose TWO health-science related careers and produce a video summarizing the training required and career details.

To begin, each group will research a few career choices that interest them. Groups will choose **TWO careers** in a lottery-style draw.

The following roles need to be filled in your group:

- 1) Camera Operator: It is your job to ensure the interview includes footage of the interviewer, the student, and the expert. Ensure that the voices can be heard clearly throughout the recording.
- 2) Interviewer: You are the host for this Titan TV clip and a student interested in this career. It is your job to introduce the faculty member and professional as well as prompt them with questions.
- 3) Faculty Member: It is your job to play the role of an instructor in the program or an admission advisor for the faculty, who can answer questions regarding admission to the program.
- 4) Professional: It is your job to play the role of a professional currently working in this career.

You must switch roles for your second career. 1 and 2 must switch with 3 and 4.

Be **creative** and **have fun** (role play with names etc.) **but be thorough!!!**

The entire video should be **4-6 minutes**.
