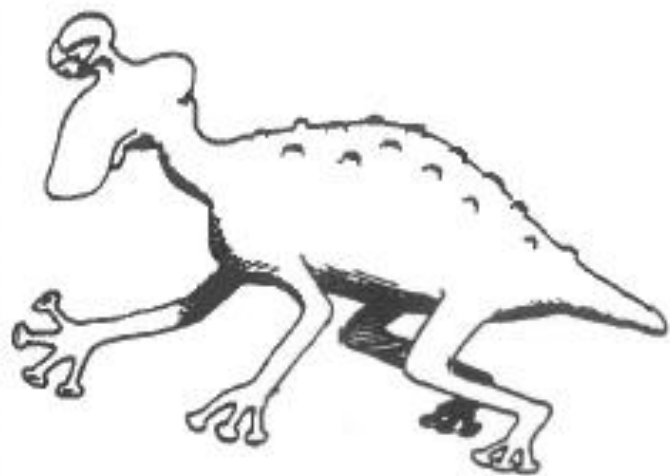


Key to the Creatures of Lost Island

1. (a) Long fur present over most of body 2
 (b) Long fur absent; skin bare 15
2. (a) Nose long and tapered, able to grasp objects 3
 (b) Nose blunt 6
3. (a) Antlers present 4
 (b) Antlers absent 5
4. (a) Walks in upright stance *Rhinostuficus vertiga*
 (b) Walks on all fours *Rostrolongis acuminata*
5. (a) Fur spotted *Contorticus vermiculatus*
 (b) Fur without spots *Proboscida concensus*
6. (a) Tusks (large teeth growing downward from upper jaw) present 7
 (b) Tusks absent 10
7. (a) Tusks shorter than head 8
 (b) Tusks as long or longer than head 9
8. (a) Bald spot on head *Chromodomus conspicus*
 (b) Bald spot lacking; head completely furred *Stumpus canidonta*
9. (a) Feet larger than head *Giganthropodicus crassa*
 (b) Feet smaller than head *Macrodonticus torpa*
10. (a) One or two horns on head 11
 (b) Horns absent 12
11. (a) Horns single; spiral shaped *Unicercus condensus*
 (b) Horns paired *Psuedobovicus cornata*
12. (a) Rear legs longer than front legs;
 adapted for leaping *Tragopus sartoria*
 (b) Rear and front legs of equal length 13
13. (a) Nostrils tube-like, projecting away from face *Nasalis tubularis*
 (b) Nostrils flush with face 14
14. (a) Tail longer than body, tufted *Hoekuspocus protracticaudis*
 (b) Tail shorter than body *Cerebrospongis borealis*

26.	(a)	Teeth visible when mouth closed	<i>Crocodilla myriodontus</i>
	(b)	Teeth not visible when mouth closed	<i>Protoneurus incognitus</i>
27.	(a)	Spikes present on head	<i>Cephalocornis punkiformis</i>
	(b)	Spikes on head absent	28
28.	(a)	Freckles present above nose	<i>Anomalous spotonasalis</i>
	(b)	Freckles above nose absent	29
29.	(a)	Skin smooth	<i>Protopicus glabrum</i>
	(b)	Skin wrinkled and folded	<i>Protopicus flabba</i>
